

Cookie Policy

What is a cookie?

A "cookie" is a piece of information that is stored on your computer's hard drive and which records how you move your way around a website so that, when you revisit that website, it can present tailored options based on the information stored about your last visit. Cookies can also be used to analyse traffic and for advertising and marketing purposes.

Cookies are used by nearly all websites and do not harm your system.

If you want to check or change what types of cookies you accept, this can usually be altered within your browser settings. You can block cookies at any time by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our site.

How do we use cookies?

We use cookies and similar technologies to operate our website, keep it secure, remember your cookie preferences, understand how visitors use the website, and improve our website and services. Some cookies are essential for the website to function properly. Other cookies, such as analytics or performance cookies, will only be used where you have given consent.

Cookies are either:

- Session cookies: these are only stored on your computer during your web session and are automatically deleted when you close your browser – they usually store an anonymous session ID allowing you to browse a website without having to log in to each page but they do not collect any personal data from your computer; or
- Persistent cookies: a persistent cookie is stored as a file on your computer and it remains there when you close your web browser. The cookie can be read by the website that created it when you visit that website again.

Cookies can also be categorised as follows:

- Strictly necessary cookies: These cookies are essential to enable you to use the website effectively, such as when buying a product and/or service, and therefore cannot be turned off. Without these cookies, the services available to you on our website cannot be provided. These cookies do not gather information about you that could be used for marketing or remembering where you have been on the internet.
- Performance cookies: These cookies enable us to monitor and improve the performance of our website. For example, they allow us to count visits, identify traffic sources and see which parts of the site are most popular.
- Functionality cookies: These cookies allow our website to remember choices you make and provide enhanced features. They may also be used to provide services you have requested, such as viewing a video, using a form, or remembering preferences. Depending on the cookie, the information collected may be anonymous or may relate to your device or use of the website.

Your Consent and Control

When you first visit our website, a cookie banner will appear asking for your consent to use non-essential cookies.

You can choose to:

- accept all cookies;
- reject all non-essential cookies; or
- customise your cookie preferences.

We will not place non-essential cookies, such as analytics, performance, functionality or targeting cookies, on your device unless you have provided consent. Consent must be given by a clear positive action, such as selecting an option on the cookie banner.

You can change or withdraw your cookie preferences at any time by using the cookie banner or cookie settings tool on our website. You may also block cookies through your browser settings, although blocking all cookies, including strictly necessary cookies, may affect the operation of the website.

Please note that third-party services used on our website, such as analytics, security, anti-spam or embedded content providers, may also use cookies or similar technologies over which we do not have direct control.
